Categories

Pieced Quilt – Pieced (280” or larger). Made to fit on a bed – twin, full, queen or king. Individually made.

Appliquéd Quilt - Appliqued (280” or larger). Made to fit on a bed – twin, full, queen or king. Individually made.

Small Wall Quilt – Pieced (up to 160”). Includes miniature quilts. Individually made.

Small Wall Quilt - Appliquéd (up to 160”). Includes miniature quilts. Individually made.

Large Wall Quilt - Pieced (161” to 279”). Individually made.

Large Wall Quilt – Appliquéd (161” to 279”). Individually made.

Innovative Quilt – (all sizes). Technique used extends beyond traditional disciplines, and exercises independence and originality in theory, color or design. If a quilt requires special handling, the owner is responsible for all transportation to and from registration, judging and the show.

Group or Duet Bed Quilt - (280” or larger). Includes any bed quilt worked on by more than one person, including those quilted by a professional quilter and Block of the Month quilts.

Group or Duet Wall Quilt (up to 279”). Includes any wall quilt worked on by more than one person, including those quilted by a professional quilter and Block of the Month quilts.

Wearable Art. Clothing made with quilt or wool techniques.

Delivery and Return of Quilts

Hand Delivery: Quilts should be brought to the Central Unitarian Church, 156 Forest Ave., Paramus, NJ on Saturday, November 5, 2011 between 10Am and 2pm. **Bring your entry receipt.**

Mail Delivery: When mailing your quilt, be sure the box is sturdy enough for shipment. Be sure the box is sturdy enough for shipment. Pickup/Return: Quilts may be picked up at the end of the show on Saturday, November 12 after 5:30PM. You must present your entry receipt to have your quilt returned to you. If someone else is picking up your quilt, they must have your written permission along with your entry receipt.

How to Enter Checklist:

- Completed entry form, one for each entry.** PLEASE PRINT! The form may be photocopied.
- Entry fee.** \$10 for each quilt to be judged, \$5 for each quilt not being judged, plus \$20 for return mailing, if applicable.
- Hanging sleeve sewn-on back.** (4” for Bed and Large Wall quilts).
- Label on back** – covered by a sewn-on muslin flap for judging.
- Photo of quilt** – in color, 4” x 6”.
- Self-addressed, stamped envelope** – if entry receipt is to be mailed to you.
- Mail entry form no later than October 8, 2011.**

Judging and Prizes

NQA certified judges will evaluate all entries and ribbons will be awarded in all categories. In addition, ribbons will be awarded for the following merit prizes: **Best in Show, Judges' Choice, Quilt Show Chair's Choice, Viewers' Choice, Best Hand Workmanship, Best Machine Workmanship and Best Use of Color.**

Entry Rules

Please read the Entry Rules carefully as the Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to disqualify any entry not meeting these criteria. The Quilt Show Committee also reserves the right to change the category of a quilt, and to eliminate a category if fewer than five pieces are entered into it. If a category is eliminated, those quilts will be reassigned into another category. All quilts will be handled with the utmost care. However, we cannot be responsible for acts of nature beyond our control. Insurance is the responsibility of the owner. (Check your Homeowner's Insurance policy.)

- 1) All quilts entered require an entry form, entry fee and a photograph of the quilt. Incomplete forms will be returned and will not qualify for entry.
- 2) The non-refundable entry fee is \$10 for each judged quilt and \$5 for each non-judged quilt. Please make checks payable to Brownstone Quilters Guild, Inc.
- 3) Entrants are limited to two quilts per person per category for judging. There is no limit on the total number of quilts you may enter.
- 4) If more than one person worked on a quilt, it must be entered in one of the Group or Duet categories. Group is defined as more than one person. Duet is defined as one top maker and one quilter and two ribbons will be awarded.
- 5) If a quilt requires special handling, the owner is responsible for all transportation to and from registration, judging and the show.
- 6) If you provide an email address, your registration receipt will be sent to you by email. If you do not, be sure to include a **SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE** with your entry. Please be sure to retain your receipt and bring it with you when you drop off and pick up the quilt.
- 7) The predominant technique used in making the top determines whether it is pieced or appliquéd.
- 8) Item(s) must not have been in a previous Brownstone Quilt Show.
- 9) Measure the entire perimeter of the quilt to determine its size.
- 10) A 4" hanging sleeve **must be sewn** on the back of all quilts except for small wall quilts and wearables.
- 11) All quilts must have a label sewn on the back, in the lower right hand corner, containing your name and the name of the quilt. If your quilt is to be judged, the label **must** be covered with a fabric patch, sewn in place on all sides, for the judging process. Please do not use freezer paper or pins.
- 12) All quilts must be clean, and free of pet hair or strong odors, including smoke.
